







Things to do with your drawings


Mounting



Take a piece of paper or cardboard, a little bigger than your drawing.



Spread glue thinly over the back of the drawing. Put it in the middle of the mount.



With clean hands. smooth your drawing down firmly.

Fancy mounts



Draw a simple pattern on your mount.

Decorate your mount with wrapping paper.



Sprinkle glitter on your mount or stick on shiny stars..

and mount with wiggly scissors.

Making a shaped card

Trim

your picture

Fold a piece of cardboard in half. Stick your drawing close to the fold. Leaving the folded side, cut around your drawing, close to the edge.





